Mr. Harry Clinton King Jr., 84, of Braddock Heights, died on Monday, Jan. 7, 2008, at the Golden Living Center, in Frederick. Born in Brunswick, on July 28, 1923, he was a son of the late Harry Clinton Sr., and Esther May Stottlemeyer King.
