Dr. Richard Madison Marrone, 72, formerly of Frederick, and most recently residing in Key West, Fla., died suddenly on Friday, Jan. 11, 2008, at the Lower Keys Medical Center.

Born in Frederick, on June 20, 1935, he was a son of the late Dr. James and Margaret Virginia Miller-- Marrone.
